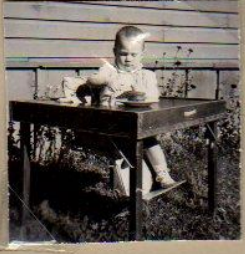
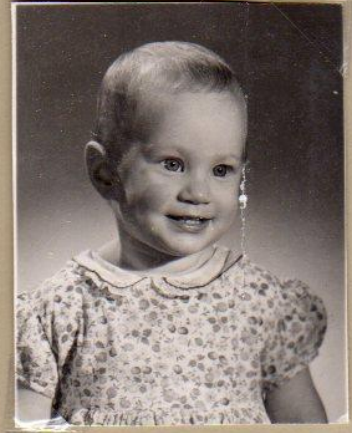
May to Aug 1947 Miriam + mother spend with

Utah, and have a 4 generations picture.



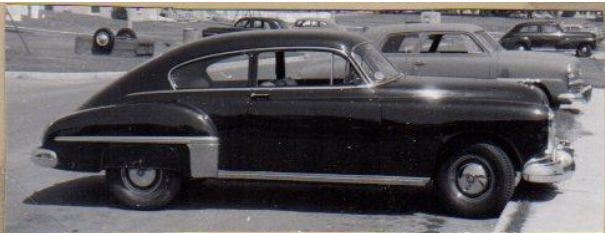




Return to Chico, CA - Daddy, Mother & Miriam

 MAY thru OCT.







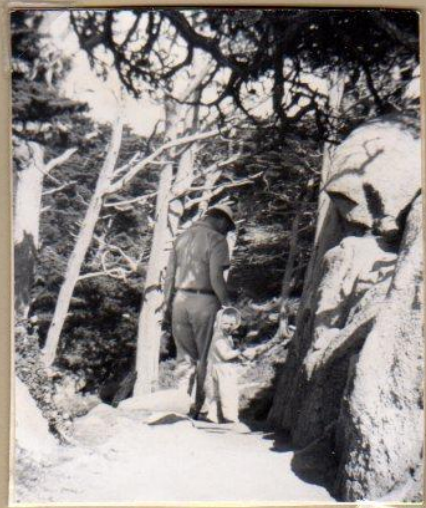
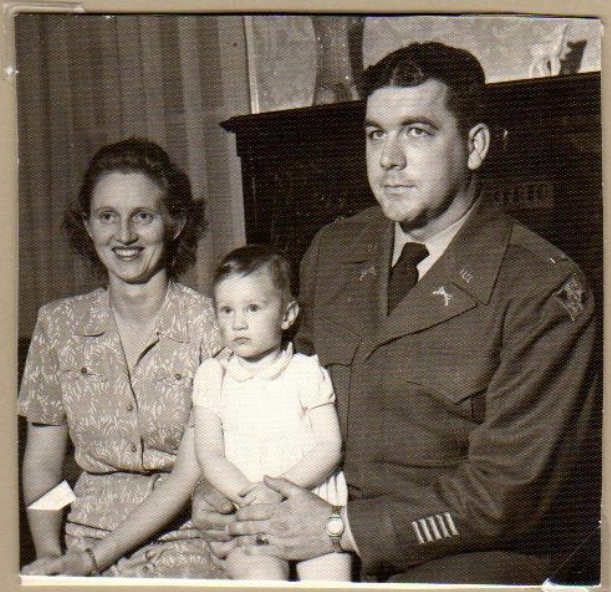
We buy a little Olds -

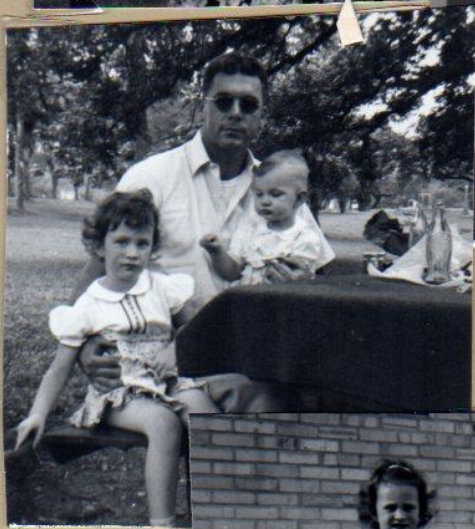








*Dick continues to take pictures and our babies grow to two little girls*
